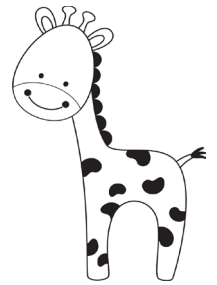


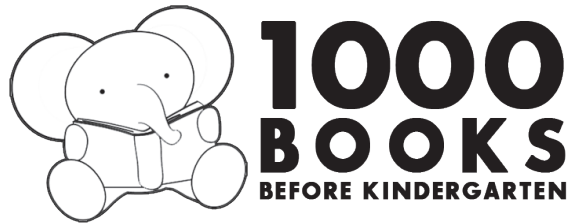

Who Can Participate?

All children from birth until the beginning of Kindergarten
with a Naperville Public Library card

How Does It Work?

- Color in a space on the reading log for every book read together.
- Any reading or listening counts – count books read aloud by a parent, caregiver, sibling, or anyone else.
- Count a book each time it's read, even if it's repeated.
- Count books read at storytime.
- When the log is completed, bring it to the Children's Desk at any Naperville Public Library for a sticker.
- When all ten logs are completed, the child's name will be placed on a bookplate in a library book.
- Have fun reading!

Early Literacy Tip

Encourage your child to think of words that begin with the same sound as other words, or words that rhyme with other words, to get him or her thinking about the sounds that make up words.
